### The Inuvik Long Distance Trip

The Inuvik trip dates are now set. We had a devil of a time getting rooms for the trip because many of the desired stops were already full. We had to juggle dates to find sufficient rooms.

- 6/27 Anchorage - Tok 325 mi. Youngs Motel.
- 28 Tok -Haines Junction 329 mi. .Alcan Motor Inn
- 29 Haines Junction- Dawson City 409 mi. .Bonanza Gold Motel
- 30 Dawson City - Eagle Plains 257 mi. Eagle Plains Hotel
- 7/1 Eagle Plains - Inuvik 225 mi. Eskimo Inn
- 2 Inuvik
- 3 Inuvik - Eagle Plains 225 mi. Eagle Plains Hotel
- 4 Eagle Plains - Dawson City 257 mi. Bonanza Gold Motel
- 5 Dawson City - Tok 185 mi. Youngs Motel
- 6 Tok - Anchorage 325 mi.

Total miles Approximately 2550 miles.  
the longest day is between Haines Junction and Dawson City - 409 mi. We had the option of over-nighting in Whitehorse and incurring a long day between Tok and Whitehorse,430 miles, and it would have been on the day that we lost an hour (time zone change) and had to clear customs. Also the road between Tok and Haines Junction is not as good as the road between Haines Junction and Dawson Creek.  
There is nothing at Eagle Plains but the hotel but

it is 500 mi. between Dawson City and Inuvik and 2 ferry crossings so that is too much for one day. The ferries cross the Peel and McKenzie rivers.

We will have a full day in Inuvik and a half day in Dawson City if one desires.  
There is a passenger only boat option between Dawson City and Eagle, Alaska on the Yukon River but this will require the drivers to drive 66 mi. from Jack Wade to Eagle to pick up the boat travelers. Several club members took this trip and reported that it was enjoyable.

There has been some discussion among the some Model A owners about driving their Model A's on this trip. This probably would be a good trip for Model A's. The Model A owners who have signed up for the trip are:Kimzey, Stout, Fredenhagen, Watts, Isham, and Fowler (hope this is correct?)  
Transit between Alaska and Canada will require a passport when we enter and leave the two countries – if you do not have a passport please apply now as it will take at least 90 days, and probably more.

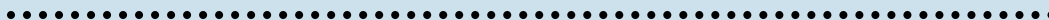

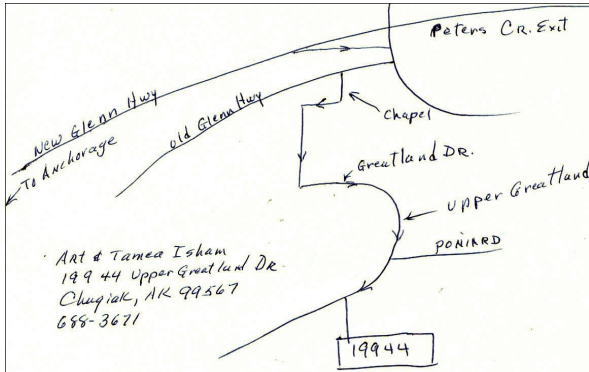

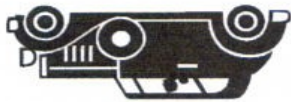
